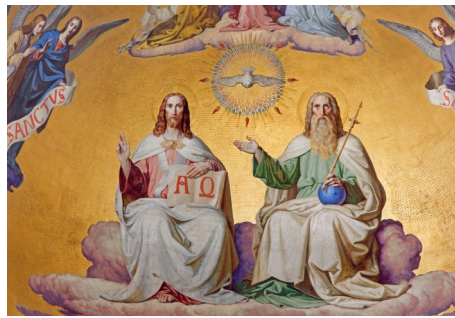

The Most Holy Trinity

After the
Easter Season
that ended
last Sunday
with Pente-
cost, the Liturgy has returned to "Ordinary Time".
This does not mean, however, that Christians must be
less any committed: indeed, having entered divine life
through the sacraments, we are called daily to be
open to the action of divine Grace, to progress in love
of God and of neighbour. This Sunday of the Most
Holy Trinity, in a certain sense, sums up God's revela-
tion, which was brought about (through the Paschal
Mysteries: Christ's death and Resurrection, his As-
cension to the right hand of the Father and the out-
pouring of the Holy Spirit. The human mind and lan-
guage are inadequate to explain the relationship that
exists between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
Yet, the Fathers of the Church sought to illustrate
the mystery of the Triune God by living it with deep
faith in their own lives. *- Pope Benedict XVI*
